## Payment & Preventive Exam Policy (10/30/2025)

### Payment Policy for Deductible and Co-Pay Plans

At **Onestop Medical Clinic**, we value transparency in our billing practices and want to ensure every patient understands what to expect at the time of their visit.

#### **Patients with Deductible Plans**

If your insurance plan includes a deductible, an \$80 payment will be collected at the time of service.

This amount will be applied toward your visit charges once your claim has been processed by your insurance provider.

After processing, you may receive a bill for any **remaining balance** based on your plan's deductible and

For patients who have already met their deductible by the time the visit is processed through insurance, if a credit balance is reflected after the claim is finalized, the credit may be refunded accordingly.

### **Patients with Co-Pay Plans**

If your insurance plan includes a co-pay, you are responsible only for your co-payment amount at the time of

No deductible payment will be collected for these visits.

#### Preventive Exams (Annual Physical / GYN Exam)

Insurance typically covers one preventive exam per year (such as an annual physical or women's health exam).

These visits are intended for routine screenings, counseling, and wellness discussions — not for evaluation of specific medical problems.

If your provider also addresses acute or chronic medical issues during your preventive visit — such as:

- New findings or symptoms
- New or changed medications
- Review or discussion of lab or imaging results
- Ongoing management of existing health conditions


Those services are not considered preventive under insurance guidelines and will be billed concurrently as a problem-oriented visit.

This may result in additional deductible and/or co-pay responsibility, depending on your individual plan.
